Last term we focused on autumn and black history month. The children were able to participate in a range of activities which can be seen in the pictures.



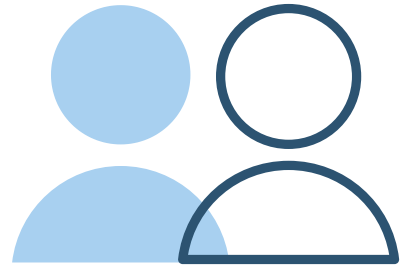
This term

Things you can do at home with your child



Talking and listening to your child will improve your child's language. This can be done through activities such as reading with your child, singing and having conversations.

How to encourage your child to communicate

- ★ Start with getting your child's attention so that they are able to focus. Reduce any distractions such as a tablet or television. It makes it easier for children to listen and engage.
- ★ Build on what your child says by adding one or two words.
- ★ If you ask your child a question give them at least 10 seconds to respond.
- ★ Use simple languages and keep sentences short.
